ESSER III Information

The United States Congress passed the Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III) in March 2021. This relief fund was part of a \$122 billion fund to help school districts impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. Indiana was awarded 1.9 billion of these funds. These funds were then appropriated to school corporations based on a perpupil formula. The ESSER III grant has been approved for Insight School of Indiana with an approved amount of \$1,188,654.62, per ESSER III guidelines at least 20% of the approved amount must go towards addressing learning loss. These funds are to be encumbered by September 30, 2024.
